University Applications

If you are applying for more than one state remember each admission centre will have different dates and timelines. You will also have to pay for each separate application you lodge. Majority of students will apply with UAC remember to get your **applications in by September 30**. Your application does not go through until you make payment of \$73. From October 1 the fee goes up to \$200. Read your UAC guide for more information (available outside the Careers Staffroom). You may choose up to 5 courses on your preference list. If you don't know what courses you want to choose that's okay just put any 5 for now and you can change them as many times as you like up until the offer round deadlines.

UAC Offer Rounds

UAC have a lot of offer rounds and it can get confusing the main ones are as follows but make sure you check the UAC guide. It is always important to put your **number 1 dream course at the top**. If you don't receive the ATAR for the course you might still be eligible with adjustment factors (previously known as bonus points) so check the relevant institution's website. You can receive up to ONE offer per round. **Always accept an offer you get**, and you can change your mind later. You are only committed to the course once you ENROL with the university. Once you accept an offer in UAC, remove it from your 5 preferences so you can be eligible for another course offer in the next round.

Schools Recommendation Scheme

We recommend you consider applying for the Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS). An early offer scheme that looks at criteria in addition to or instead of your ATAR. Offers can be conditional and unconditional depending on the institution's requirements. For more info [Click here SRS](#)

Scholarships or Early Entry Applications

If you are applying for scholarships and or early entry you must see the Careers Advisers at LEAST 3 weeks prior to submission. This enables time to help you draft your application and ensure the appropriate documentation can be organised. Visit the Year 12 Careers Team Channel for the Co-op scholarship application guide. We strongly urge you to apply for ANY scholarships as many go unfilled! Once you get to university you can also apply for scholarships each year which can support you financially and provide extra opportunities you may not have considered. Check out each universities website as they offer various scholarships on offer and you can filter by various categories/eligibility.

References

In *MOST* cases you DO NOT require a reference for a scholarship. Some applications might need a specific document from the school such as the JCU medicine application. In some applications such as the UNSW Co-op scholarship the Careers Advisers can upload supporting documentation. In this instance, you can request an early school reference. If you think you might need supporting documents then get organised and do not leave it until last minute, otherwise we may not be able to organise in time for you. Please keep in mind the substantial cost (in most instances) to study overseas so you must do your research before committing to the process.
